## PREFACE

The German Interest Group, composed of persons involved in German-American genealogical research, began in 1987 under the auspices of the Western Pennsylvania Genealogical Society. Initially, the group was formed as a support group for those researchers of common interest; and as a forum for the exchange of facts, ideas, and the like.

From the group interest grew a project known as the Library Project. The purpose was to locate and record resources of German-American interest, primarily books, in selected libraries within the City of Pittsburgh and a short distance surrounding the City.

German Interest Group members who worked on this Project include:

William Yerrick who suggested the project, undertook the entering of data on the computer as it was collected, and worked up the initial introductory material.

James Fair who collected information for entries at Duquesne University Library and the University of Pittsburgh, Hillman Library.

Ruth Renton who collected information for entries at the Citizens Library of Washington, Pennsylvania, and The Carnegie Library of Pittsburgh.

Margarette Evans who collected information at the Historical Society of Western Pennsylvania Library, coordinated the location of the books, and edited copy.

Jean Gregord, C.G.R.S., who collected information at The Carnegie Library, edited copy, and completed the final composition and layout on the computer of this material that became a publication.

Special thanks are due to the staffs of all six libraries who assisted in ways even they may not realize; to the Board of Directors of the Western Pennsylvania Genealogical Society; and to Suzanne Johnston, Publications Chairman of WPGS, who arranged the final publication details.

The German Interest Group Library Project Committee has great respect for the resources available through the Stake Branch Family History Library of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints. The local branch has considerable microform holdings, and a small book collection. In addition, they can call on the tremendous microform resources of the central LDS facility, the Family History Library in Salt Lake City, Utah.

### EXPLANATORY COMMENTS

Each entry identifies the library/libraries in which we located that particular book to the best of our efforts. Since the libraries are continuing to add to their collections regularly, you may find additions.

Entries can be identified by author in the card catalog or on-line catalog in the library holding the material, unless otherwise noted. Entries that had no author, compiler, or editor identified are listed by title only.

We have not included in the entry every edition of a book that was located. Editions may vary from library to library. If a researcher desires a particular edition, it would be advisable to query the most convenient library/libraries holding that material.

We have not included every work of an author that we may have found in an individual library.

Due to indexing by title on the computer, the articles, "a, an, the" do not appear as the first word of a title; just as they are ignored in searching for a title in a card catalog.

While the majority of the books listed are reference books to be used in the library, some of the books do circulate. Inquire about the borrowing policies of the individual library, including participation in ACCESS PENNSYLVANIA and Interlibrary Loan.

The Carnegie Library of Pittsburgh is a tax supported public library located at 4400 Forbes Avenue, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, 15213, in the Oakland section of Pittsburgh. The Pennsylvania Department, the Social Sciences Department, and the adjoining Microfilm Room are located on the second floor of the library, which can be reached by an elevator.

The Pennsylvania Department has materials for genealogical research, and for local and state historical research. Knowledgeable staff members are available at all times to assist researchers in the use of the department's card catalog and library materials. [Books in this department do not circulate.] Limited reference service is available by phone (412) 622-3154. Correspondence will be answered at no charge, but a self-addressed stamped envelope is appreciated. Because of staff limitations, no extensive or original research can be done by the staff. Photocopy orders by mail will be filled at a charge of \$0.50 a copy with a \$3.00 minimum per order, plus postage. The 6% Pennsylvania sales tax is collected where applicable. Prepayment is required on all photocopy orders.



The Social Sciences Department holds the library's extensive general history and social sciences collections. Staff assistance is available at all times to assist patrons in locating both the reference and circulating books in the department. The card catalog for the entire library is located in this room.

The Carnegie Library participates in the ACCESS PENNSYLVANIA system. Department staff will assist researchers in obtaining materials through Interlibrary Loan.

Each department has self-service copy machines. The Microfilm Room also has reader/printer machines. The cost is \$0.10 per copy.

Summer hours are: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday from 9:00 A.M. to 9:00 P.M.; Thursday and Saturday from 9:00 A.M. to 5:30 P.M.; closed Sundays. During the winter months, the library is open on Sunday from 1:00 P.M. to 5:00 P.M. Call (412) 622-3131 to confirm.

Duquesne University is a private Roman Catholic University located on "The Bluff" at the eastern edge of Downtown Pittsburgh. The Library Resource Center is on Locust Street, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, 15282. While this library does not have a genealogy section, the collection is rich in local, national, and international history resources.

Copy machines are available for public use at \$0.10 per copy.

Directions: Follow Forbes Avenue in Downtown Pittsburgh, east; turn right at either Shingiss or Colbert Streets; turn left onto Locust Street. Library is on the left-hand side. There is limited metered parking space (\$0.25 per half hour) in front of the library. There is also a pay parking garage at Forbes Avenue and Hooper Streets, with an elevator to the hilltop campus.

PAT buses run regularly along Forbes and Fifth Avenues and have stops for Duquesne University.

Summer hours are Monday - Thursday from 8:00 A.M. to 10:00 P.M.; Friday from 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.; Saturday from 8:30 A.M. to 4:30 P.M.; closed Sunday. Phone ahead for hours of opening: (412) 434-6130.

The Historical Society of Western Pennsylvania Library is located at 4338 Bigelow Boulevard, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, 15213, in the Oakland section of Pittsburgh. The collection is strong in the history of early Western Pennsylvania as well as the tri-state area.

Also housed in the library is the extensive collection of the Western Pennsylvania Genealogical Society covering a broad spectrum of genealogical subjects, including some audio tapes and microfilms.

HSWP Librarians assist with both collections. Limited mail and telephone service is also available.

Hours of opening are: Tuesday - Saturday from 9:30 A.M. to 4:30 P.M. Closed Sunday and Monday. Call (412) 681-5533 for information and confirmation of hours.

The Darlington Memorial Library is located in Room 601 of the University of Pittsburgh Cathedral of Learning at Fifth Avenue and Bigelow Boulevard, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, 15260. The collections are especially rich in both primary and secondary source materials for the American Colonial period, the French and Indian Wars, the American Revolution, and the War of 1812. The Darlington Collection of Americana emphasizes Western Pennsylvania and Ohio Valley regional materials. Holdings in this library do not circulate.

The Darlington Room is generally open Monday - Friday from 1:00 P.M. to 5:00 P.M. Phone (412) 624-4491 to confirm hours.

The University of Pittsburgh, Hillman Library is located at Forbes Avenue and Bigelow Boulevard, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, 15260, in the Oakland section. It is diagonally across Forbes Avenue from the Cathedral of Learning. The library houses special collections, government documents, periodicals, microforms, maps, and reference and circulating books in the social sciences, history, and other academic subjects.

Information about these materials can be found in PITTCAT, the online catalog, and the card catalog. Both are located on the Ground Floor of Hillman Library.

Assistance is available at the information Desk. There are racks of informational and directional literature. Guidance information for use of the PITTCAT terminals is strategically placed.

The Archives of Industrial Society is located in Room 363-F of Hillman Library. The AIS is a collection of historical records of Pittsburgh and Western Pennsylvania. Included are business records, institutional records, church records and civic organizational records. The AIS is open Monday - Friday from 8:30 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. Call in advance to confirm hours and to give the staff an indication of the material you are seeking. (412) 648-7977.

Microform Collections are located on the Second Floor of Hillman Library. Included in the holdings are census records, newspapers, U. S. city directories, manuscripts and journals.

Copy machines are located throughout the library. Cost is \$0.10 per copy.

Summer hours at Hillman Library are: Monday - Thursday from 7:50 A.M. to 10:00 P.M.; Friday from 7:50 A.M. to 8:00 P.M.; Saturday from 9:00 A.M. to 5:30 P.M.; Sunday from 12:00 P.M. to 10:00 P.M. Winter hours are extended. Hours vary during semester periods. Call (412) 648-7715 for hours of opening.

**PARKING IN OAKLAND**, for any of the four libraries, is difficult. The best time to find a spot is early morning or late afternoon.

The Carnegie has a parking lot with the entrance at Forbes Avenue and Craig Street. A discount price of \$3.00 is available to library patrons, if you have your parking ticket stamped at the main desk on the first floor of the library.

A metered parking lot (scheduled to become a pay as you enter lot) is located in the Plaza or Quadrangle between The Carnegie Library and the Hillman Library. The rate is currently \$0.25 per half hour.

There is a parking lot across the street from the Historical Society of Western Pennsylvania. Rates vary. Usually it is \$6.00 per day, less on Saturday. Limited metered parking space is available near the HSWP. The current rate is \$0.25 per half hour.

Since parking in the Oakland section is at a premium, avoid driving in the Fall on days of University of Pittsburgh football home games.

PAT buses run regularly along Forbes and Fifth Avenues. Call the Port Authority of Allegheny County for information.

Citizens Library of Washington County is a tax supported public library. Its comprehensive collection of local history and genealogy materials is located in a locked private room on the first floor. The room is accessible any hour the library is open by requesting admittance at the Charging Desk. Copy machines are located on the first floor, and are available for public use at \$0.15 per copy. The library participates in the ACCESS PENNSYLVANIA system.

Citizens Library is located at 55 South College Street, Washington, Pennsylvania, 15301, across from Washington and Jefferson College. Metered parking is located behind the library. Directions from Pittsburgh: follow Route #1-79 South to Washington, Pennsylvania and exit at Route #19 South; or take Route #19 from Pittsburgh south to Washington. Follow signs to Washington and Jefferson College.

Citizens Library summer hours are: Monday - Thursday from 10:00 A.M. to 9:00 P.M.; Friday from 10:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M.; Saturday from 10:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.; closed on Sunday. Open Friday evening and Sunday afternoon in the winter. Phone to confirm hours of opening. (412) 222-2400.

The Family History Library of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints, Stake Branch Library is located in Greentree Borough in the Southwest area of Allegheny County. The address is 46 School Street, Greentree, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, 15220. Correspondence should be sent to P.O. Box 16217, Pittsburgh, PA, 15242.

A copy machine is available for public use at \$0.10 per copy. Microfiche may be copied on Tuesday and Wednesday, and microfilm on Thursday and Saturday. The cost is \$0.25 per paper copy.

Directions: Take Route #1-79 (Parkway West) from Pittsburgh, west to the Greentree Exit. Follow the road to the left to Mansfield Road. Turn left, and follow Mansfield Road through the traffic light to School Street. The Family History Library is on the right-hand side immediately beyond the traffic light.

From Route #I-79 going east toward Pittsburgh, take Greentree Exit to Greentree Road, turn left; follow Greentree Road to first traffic light; turn left onto Mansfield Road. Follow Mansfield Road through the next traffic light to School Street. The Library is on the right-hand side.

Hours of opening are: Tuesday and Thursday from 10:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M.; Wednesday from 10:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M.; Saturday from 10:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. Closed Monday, Friday and Sunday. The Library is closed during the last two weeks of August and on certain church conference days. Call to confirm times: (412) 921-2115.

PAT buses service this area. Call the Port Authority of Allegheny County for information.
